

Competition Rules and General Guidance

1. There is no charge to enter this competition.
2. Entries are restricted to one choir per school.
3. The minimum number of children in the choir is 8 and the maximum is 16.
4. Two pieces are to be performed as follows:-
 - a) set piece "Calypso Carol"
 - b) own choice with a Christmas theme.
5. The maximum time for the combined performance is 6 minutes.
6. The pieces can be sung to a pre-recorded or keyboard accompaniment.
7. Judging of the performance will be by a panel selected by the Rotary Club. The decision of this panel will be final.
8. A winner's certificate will be given to the 1st placed choir and a participation certificate will be given to every school choir member.
9. A winner's trophy to retain for one year will be awarded to the 1st placed choir.
10. Cash prizes to promote music in school will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed choirs in the amount of £100, £75 and £50 respectively.

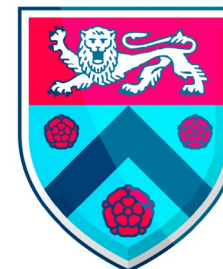
